СПРАВОЧНЫЕ МАТЕРИАЛЫ

The Present Simple Tense (Простое настоящее время)

The Present Simple Tense используется для обозначения действий, которые происходят регулярно, часто или всегда истинны. Это время также может использоваться для описания фактов, привычек, общих истин и расписаний.

Сигнальные слова (Signal Words)

Сигнальные слова помогают распознать использование The Present Simple Tense в предложениях. Вот некоторые из них:

- always (всегда);
- usually (обычно);
- often (часто);
- sometimes (иногда);
- never (никогда);
- every day/week/month/year (каждый день/неделю/месяц/год);
- on Mondays (по понедельникам);
- in the morning/afternoon/evening (утром/днем/вечером).

Образование предложений

1. Повествовательное предложение (Affirmative Sentence)

Subject + Base Verb (+ s/es для третьего лица единственного числа).

Пример: I play football. (Я играю в футбол.)

Пример с третьим лицом единственного числа: He plays football. (Он играет в футбол.)

2. Вопросительное предложение (Interrogative Sentence)

Do/Does + Subject + Base Verb?

Пример: **Do** you play football? (Ты играешь в футбол?)

Пример с третьим лицом: **Does** he play football? (Он играет в футбол?)

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СЛОВООБРАЗОВАНИЕ

СПОСОБЫ ОБРАЗОВАНИЯ СУЩЕСТВИТЕЛЬНЫХ

Образование существительных в английском языке часто осуществляется с помощью суффиксов и префиксов. Суффиксы обычно указывают на часть речи (например, существительное), а префиксы изменяют значение слова. Вот основные суффиксы и префиксы, используемые для создания существительных, вместе с примерами:

Префиксы

Префиксы присоединяются к началу слова. Они могут менять значение слова или создавать новое слово с противоположным значением.

1. Un- (не-, без-)

Этот префикс используется для создания антонимов.

Example: **un**kindness (недоброжелательность), **un**happiness (несчастье)

2. Dis- (не-)

Обычно указывает на отсутствие чего-либо или противоположное действие.

Example: disbelief (неверие), dishonesty (нечестность)

3. Pre- (пре-, до-)

Указывает на предшествующее время или положение.

Example: **pre**history (предыстория), **pre**view (предварительный просмотр)

4. Post- (пост-, после-)

Указывает на последующее время или положение.

Example: postgraduate (аспирант), postmodernism (постмодернизм)

5. Anti- (анти-)

Указывает на противостояние чему-либо.

Example: antivirus (антивирус), antifascism (антифашизм)

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


